Regarding: Academic Progress Update for Quarter 3

The Purpose of this communication is to provide the Board with information regarding academic metrics for Fresno Unified. We adjusted our assessment windows as State and COVID-19 Health guidance continues to evolve and change, so i-Ready Diagnostic 3 administration is planned for May, and the assessment results will be shared in a later communication.

The metrics included in this Board communication are:

- Quarter 2 and Quarter 3 2020/21 academic grades, including disproportionality among student groups.
  - Only students in grades 3-12 receive letter grades during Quarter 2, however, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students begin receiving letter grades in Quarter 3.
  - Academic grades in elementary are composite grades that combine both writing and reading.
- Quarter 3 2019/20 and 2020/21 academic grades
  - Students in grades 2-12 receive letter grades beginning in Quarter 3.
  - Academic grades in elementary are composite grades that combine both writing and reading.
- 2020/21 Cycle 3 redesignation and comparison of redesignation during Quarter 3 2019/20 to 2020/21


Supervisors of Schools (SOS), English Learner Services, Curriculum, Instruction, and Professional Learning (CIPL), and Equity and Access (E&A) departments are leading important actions and next steps associated with these unprecedented times:

- Assessment Committee and Assessment Sub-Committees continue to meet toward recommending next steps and alignment of assessments. For 2020/21, a recommendation by the Kindergarten Sub-Committee was the addition of the Foundational Skills Assessments (FSA) tool for capturing data in conjunction with i-Ready data. Dual Language Immersion Kinder assessment equivalency is in progress and being developed.
- School sites continue to engage in grading conversations and guidance to align their practices to the Board Policies (BP) and Administrative Regulations (AR).
- School sites continue to do outreach to families of students who are not participating in either asynchronous and/or synchronous instruction.
- Schools continue to leverage school Professional Learning Communities (PLC) and Instructional Leadership Teams (ILT) toward consistency in grading practices.

- Departments continue to use data from all sources as opportunities to learn, inform, and guide next steps in the areas of instruction, professional learning, and accountability.

Also included in this Board communication are district-level regional and student group reports for Quarter 3 and Quarter 3 2020/21 academic grades, Quarter 3 2019/20 and 2020/21 academic grades, and Cycle 3 2020/21 English Learner redesignation rates.

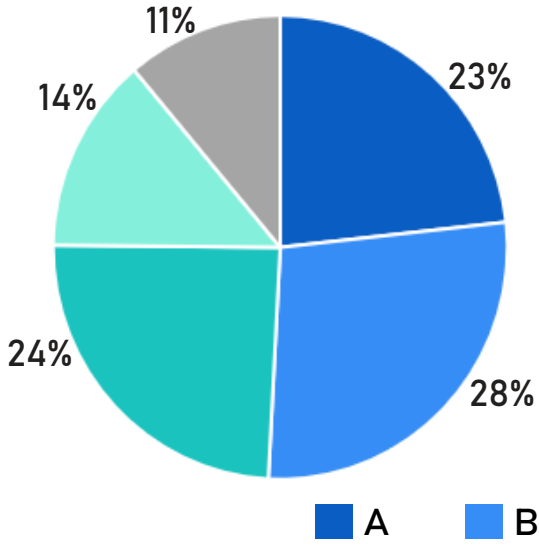

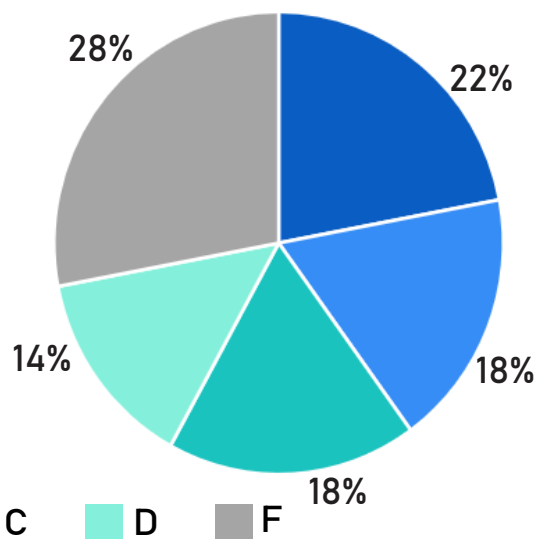

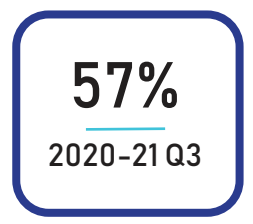
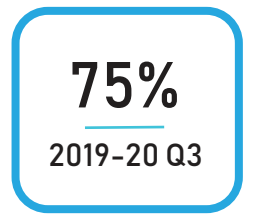

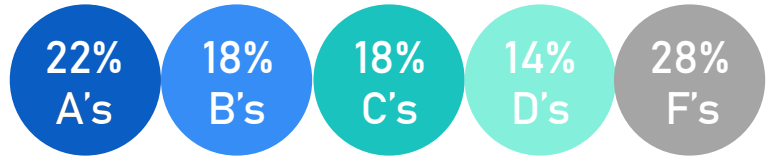
### Percent of Passing Grades in ELA

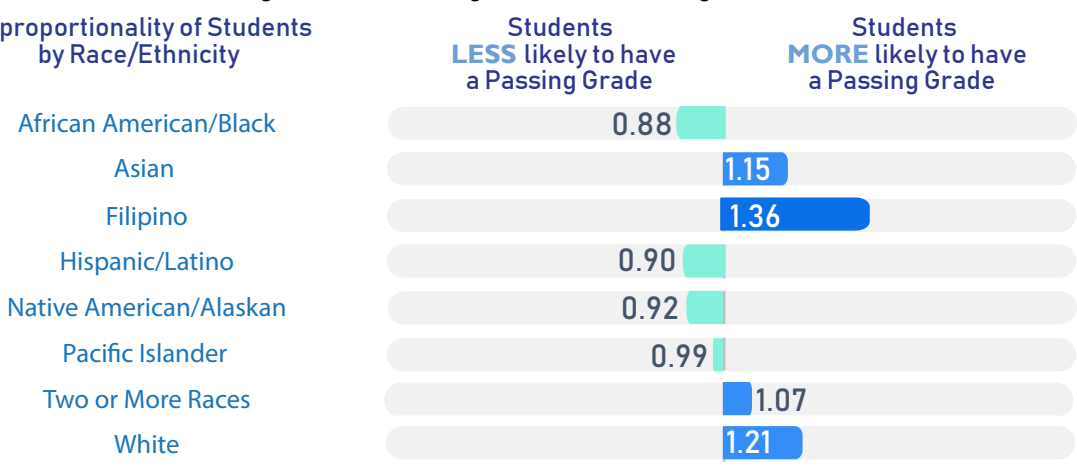

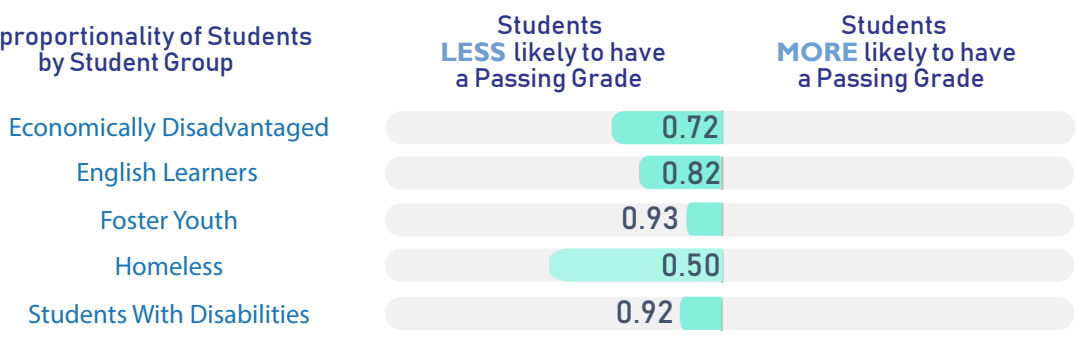

### Disproportionality of Students by Race/Ethnicity

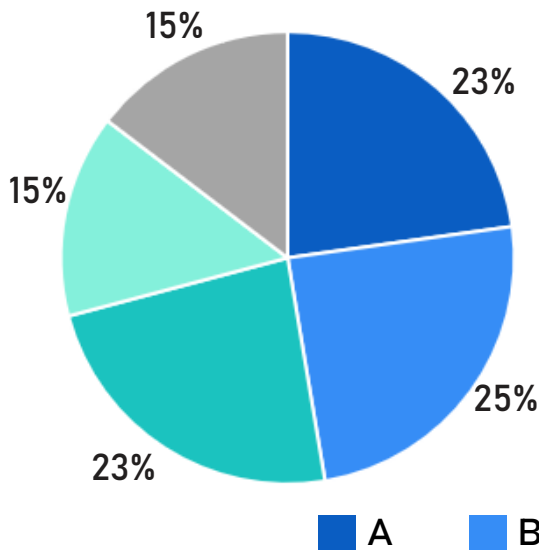


### Disproportionality of Students by Student Group

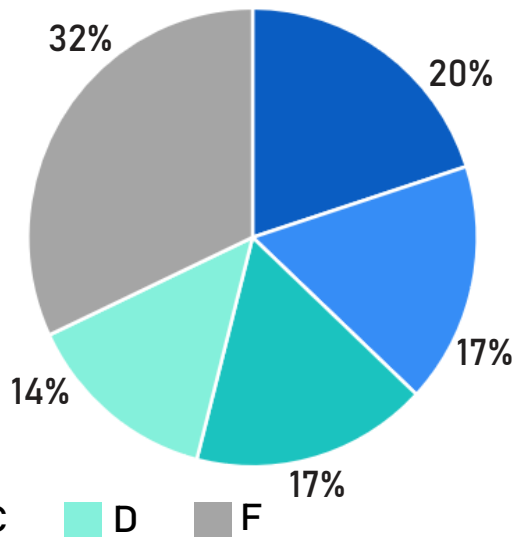

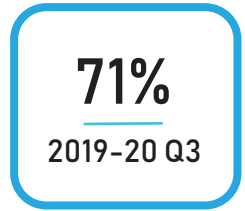

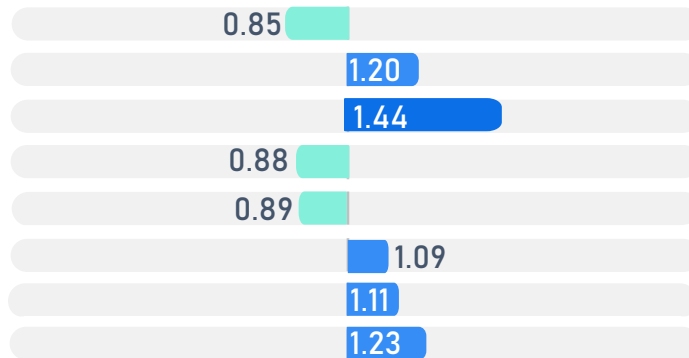

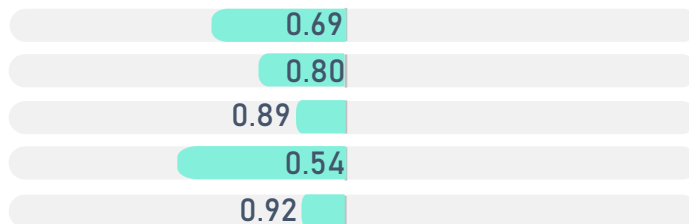

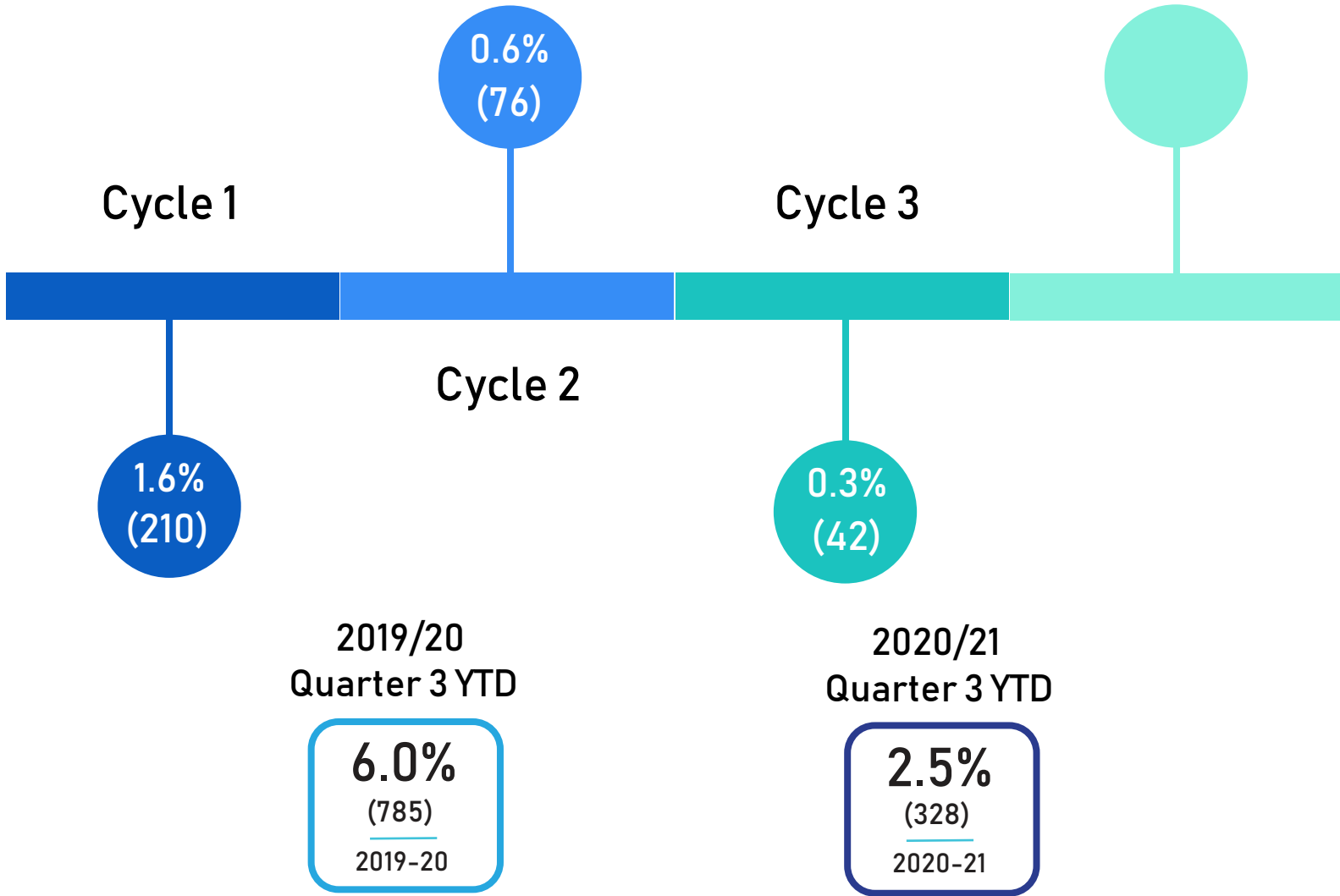

Regarding: Special Education Progress Update for Quarter 3

The Purpose of this communication is to provide the Board information regarding Fresno Unified's Special Education (SPED) programs and services. Please note that all data shown in the attached infographic only includes students in TK-12 who receive SPED services.

The following metrics for 2019/20 and 2020/21 are included on the attached infographic:

- Quarter 3 Special Education enrollment
  - Enrollment information by program type, and disproportionality among student groups
  - Enrollment in the infographic includes students in grades TK to 12 who were eligible to receive special education services, in alignment with CDE, however, the Special Education Department serves students birth to TK and in adulthood (18 to 22 years of age).
- 2019/20 and 2020/21 Quarter 3 academic grades in ELA and Math Grades
  - Only students in grades 2-12 receive letter grades.
  - Note that passing grades include C- and above
- 2020/21 Quarter 2 and Quarter 3 academic grades in ELA and Math Grades
  - Only students in grades 3-12 receive letter grades in Quarter 2. Second grade students begin receiving letter grades in Quarter 3 as well.
  - Note that passing grades include C- and above
- Quarter 3 chronic absenteeism rates, including disproportionality among student groups
- Quarter 3 suspension rates, including disproportionality among student groups
  - Please note that students with no disproportionality calculation had no student currently suspended for Quarter 3 in the 2020/21 academic year. Also, there were no expulsions for Quarter 3 in the current school year, so this metric was not included.
- Quarter 3 IEP compliance rate for IEPs that were completed up to Quarter 3
  - IEP compliance rate includes the number of students enrolled at the end of Quarter 3 who completed an IEP meeting between the start of school and the end of Quarter 3.
  - Please note that this may include students who completed their IEPs late (past the expected date in Q1, Q2, or Q3) and early (before the expected date in Q4).
  - The State still considers late IEPs, completed outside of their due date, compliant as long as it still occurs within the academic year.
  - Students who still have an upcoming IEP later this year (Q4), even if it has not yet been held, are still considered in compliance.

Please note that disproportionality refers to a student group's representation in a particular category that differs from the representation of other student groups in that same category. A disproportionality ratio of 1.0 indicates that the student group is being equally represented in that specific data measure

as they are in our total population. The higher the ratio, the higher they are being represented. Student groups that have a disproportionality ratio above 1.0 are over-represented in a particular category. Student groups that have a disproportionality ratio below 1.0 are under-represented in a particular category. For example, a ratio of 2.0 means that a particular student group is being represented twice as much in the category compared to their representation in the total student population.

The Special Education Department has taken the following action steps to improve student outcomes

- Case managers working closely with families to meet individual needs and implement IEP services
- Continued focus on inclusionary opportunities to increase access
- Winter session with appropriate IEP support
- Provide credit recovery for high school students
- Conduct in-person eligibility assessments
- Provide in-person designated instructional services (DIS) for students with greatest need
- Provide IEP support for in-person cohorts at each campus
- Piloting in-person services for youngest students in moderate/severe program at five sites
- Provide online resources for both staff and parents
- Provide specialized equipment and technology for increased access
- Provide professional learning opportunities to support distance learning for teachers and paraprofessionals
- Facilitate department collaboration through professional learning communities and job-alike meetings for teachers

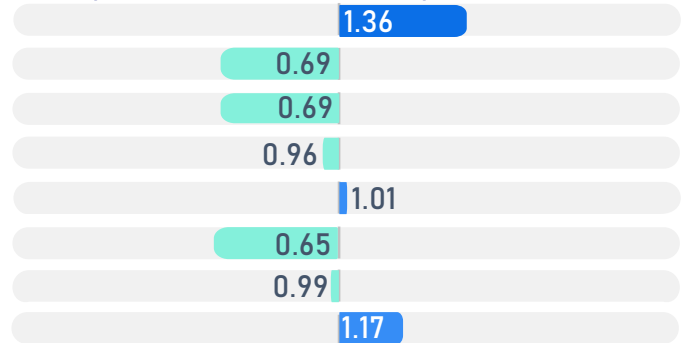

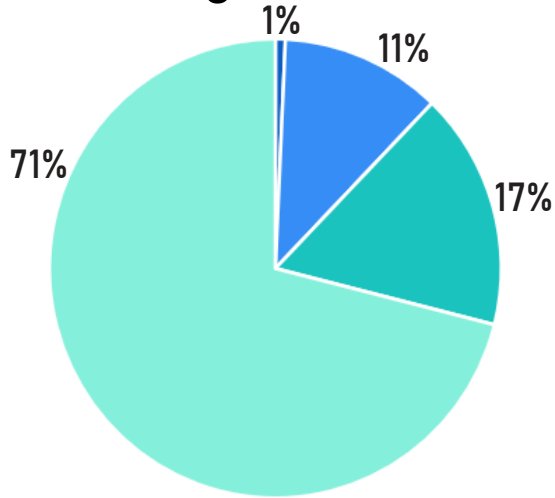

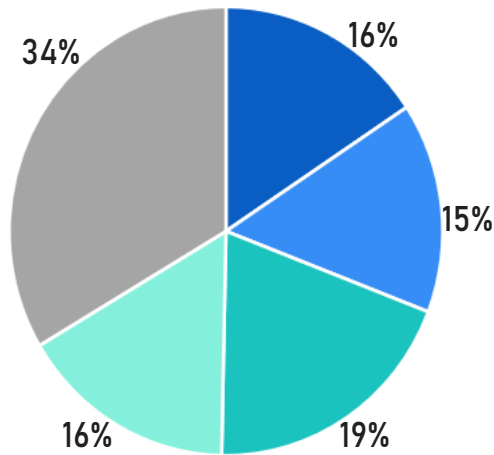

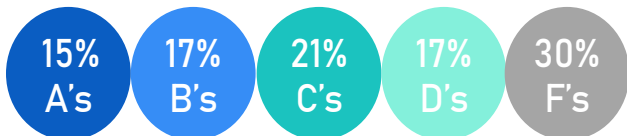

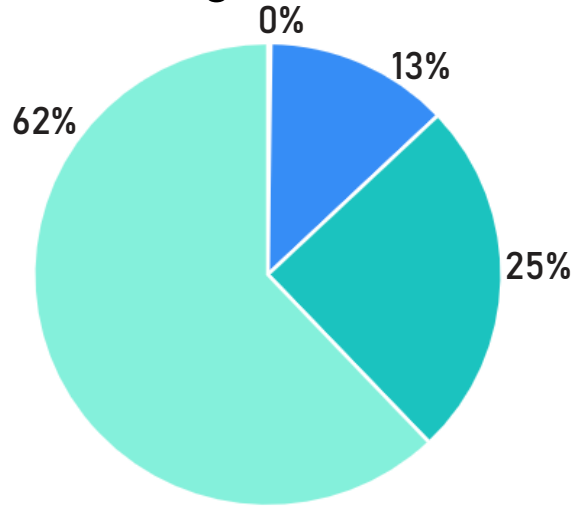
Change in the percent of students on or above grade level from Diagnostic 1 to Diagnostic 2

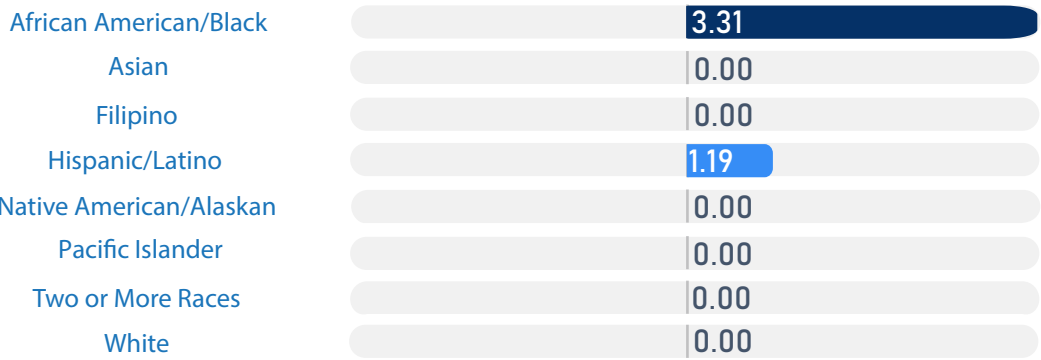

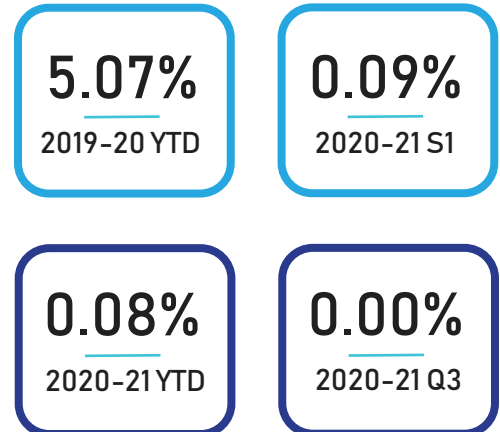

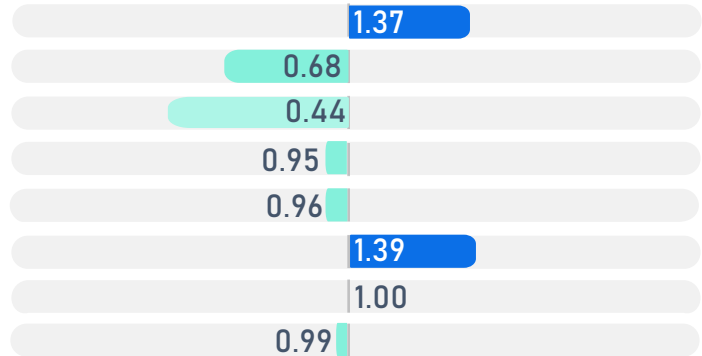
