Regarding: Climate and Culture Quarter 4 Progress Update

The purpose of this communication is to provide the Board information regarding climate and culture metrics for Fresno Unified during quarter 4.

The metrics included in this report are:

- Quarter 3 and Quarter 4/Semester 2 2020/21 chronic absenteeism rates, including disproportionality among student groups.
- Year to date 2019/20 and 2020/21 chronic absenteeism rates
- Quarter 3 and Quarter 4/Semester 2 suspension and expulsion rates, including disproportionality among student groups.
 - Please note: The size of the student group impacts the disproportionality rate. Small changes in student groups with small population sizes can result in large changes in disproportionality rates. For example, although only one homeless youth has been suspended, there is a 11.25% disproportionality rate due to the small number of homeless students enrolled in the district.
- Year to date 2019/20 and 2020/21 student misbehaviors, suspension rates, and expulsion rates.
 - Please note that students with no disproportionality calculation had no students suspended for Quarter 4 in the 2020/21 academic year. Also, there are currently no expulsions for Quarter 4 of the 2020/21 academic year, so disproportionality was unable to be calculated.

Included in this communication is an infographic with the Climate and Culture metric results in more detail. Additionally, district-level climate and culture reports that show results for student group, region, and schools are included. Please note that in alignment with CDE, any student group or grade level with a sample size less than 11 is suppressed.

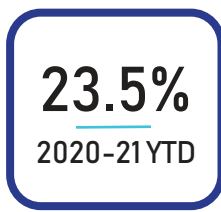

20/21 Q3 to Q4 Comparison

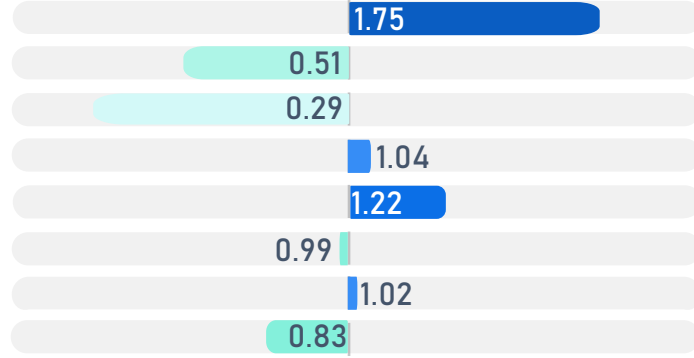

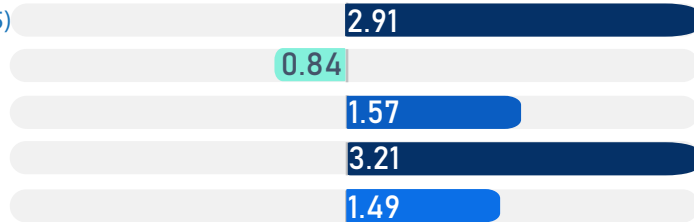


Disproportionality of Students by Student Group

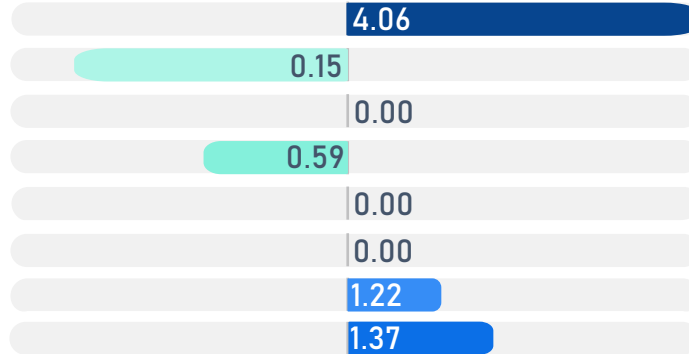

20/21 Q3 to Q4 Comparison

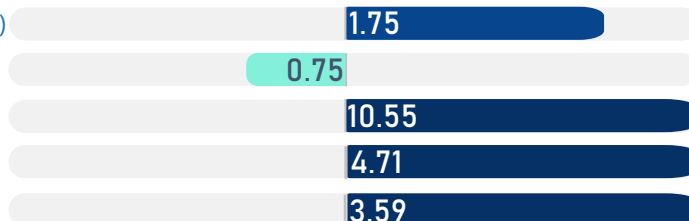


Disproportionality of Students by Student Group

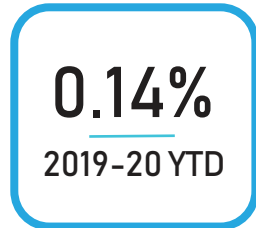

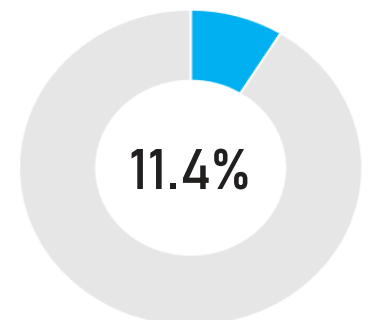
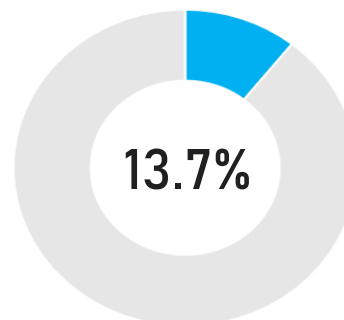
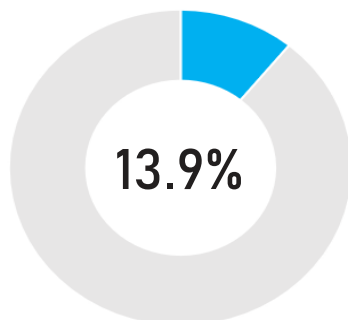
20/21 Q3 to Q4

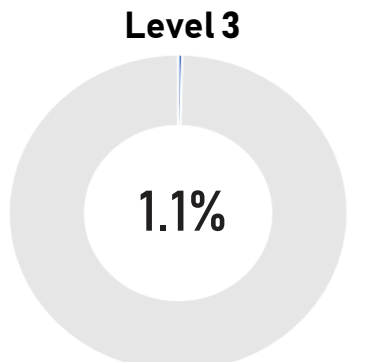
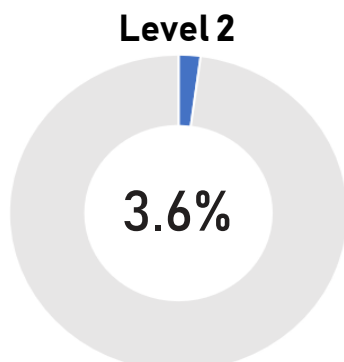
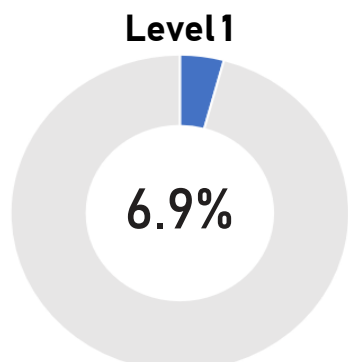
